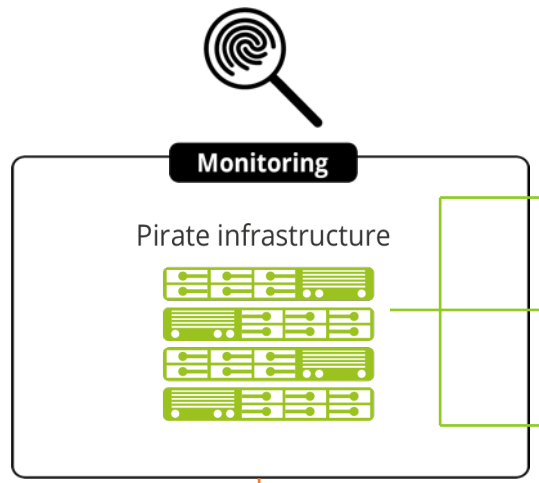
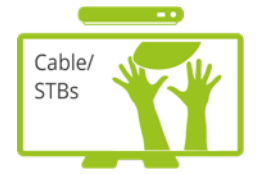

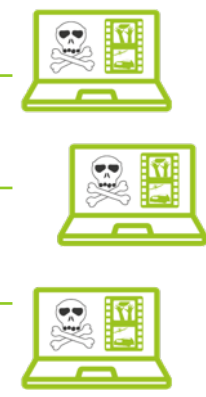


Rights holder's distribution

DISTRIBUTION NETWORKS

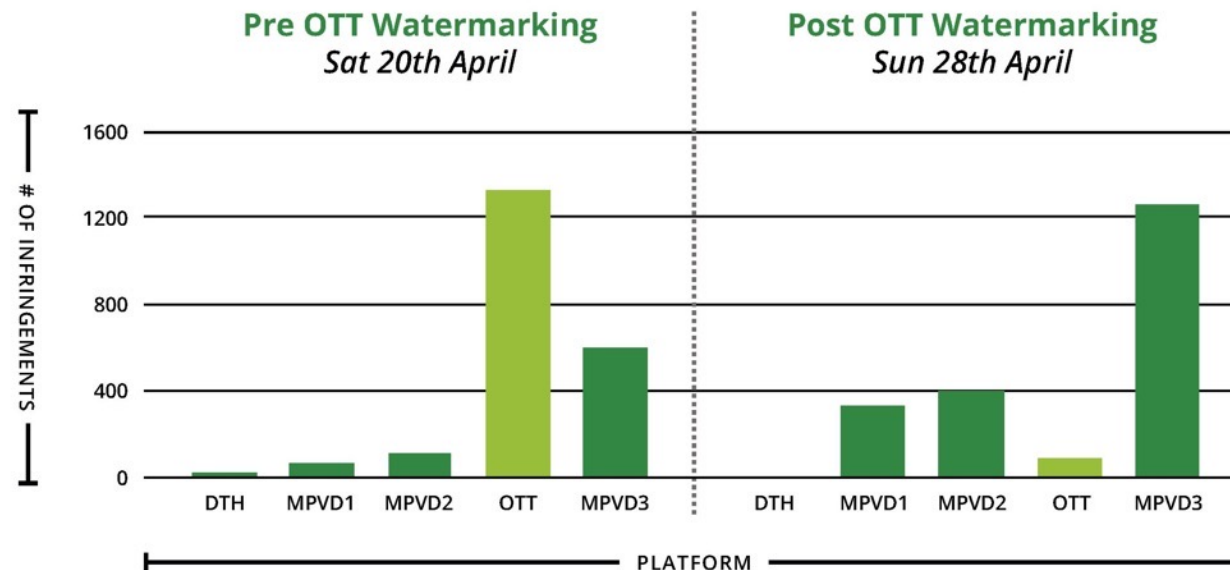

Real world effective results

- Objective: identify, locate and cut off access to the source of piracy
- Major OTT platform cut sports piracy of protected channels by 97% within days
- Tier 1 broadcaster reduced set-top box piracy of protected channels by 98%



Takeaways

- Pirates will always choose the cheapest, easiest to capture and most scalable service to source from
- If the entire distribution chain is not protected, none of it is
- A comprehensive, well-implemented security system deters pirates
- Know your infrastructure, get to know its potential attack vectors – consult the experts
- Enforcement does work – but more legislation definitely helps!
